Stats. deliberating or negotiating the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or conducting other specified public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require closed session. Specifically, to be discussed is TID #6 Developer Agreement. Present in Closed Session will be Village Board, Village Administrator, and Assistant Administrator/Clerk.
  - c. Motion to return to Open Session pursuant to Section 19.85(2) Wis. Stats. to act on items from Closed Session (possible action)
